

Indications for use

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- 1. Correction of age-related skin changes (small and medium wrinkles, atrophy, skin laxity, alignment of microrelief).
- 2. Preparation of the skin before excessive sun exposure, active rehabilitation therapy after exposure to the sun.
- 3. Circulatory disorders of the skin (couperosis).
- 4. Prevention and correction of the early signs of aging and photoaging.
- 5. Prevention of degenerative changes in the skin during hormonal changes.
- 6. Preparation for carrying out and rehabilitation after chemical peels, laser and mechanical exfoliation, and plastic surgery.

02 Therapy protocol and administration technique

Therapy protocol and administration technique

It is recommended for the therapy to carried out in 3 stages:

1st stage	2nd stage	3rd stage
3 to 4 sessions with an interval of 7-15 days	2 sessions with an interval of 1 month	1 to 2 sessions every 2-6 months
Injection Techniques: Retrograde Linear	Needles: 30G x 12 / 13mm	
Median nappage Micro-papular	30 / 32G x 6mm 32 / 33G x 4mm


- Hematomas

- Permanent makeup
- Injection of botulinum toxin type A
- Radiowave lifting
- Laser Treatment

06 recovery is recommended after the procedure weeks

• Avoid prolonged exposure to sun





 Avoid visiting public baths, saunas, gymnasiums, and fitness centers.



 Avoid using aggressive skin cleansers (scrubs, peels, brushes, and washcloths).



• Regularly apply an agent with anti-inflammatory and regenerating effects.



 Avoid scratching or rubbing the skin.

On the first day after treatment, mild swelling and slight reddening of the skin may occur. Anti-inflammatory products can be applied to reduce them.

Micropapules formed during mesotherapy and traces of injection disappear within 2 to 3 days.



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
